



## VIDEOGRAPHY MENTORSHIP PROGRAM

**GET INVOLVED:** The Des Moines Social Club is looking for candidates to join our Videography Mentorship Program. The unpaid mentorship program will give students the opportunity to gain hands-on experience in videography.

**WHAT WE DO:** The Des Moines Social Club (DMSC) is a non-profit organization that uses art and culture as a catalyst to create unprecedented community engagement.
